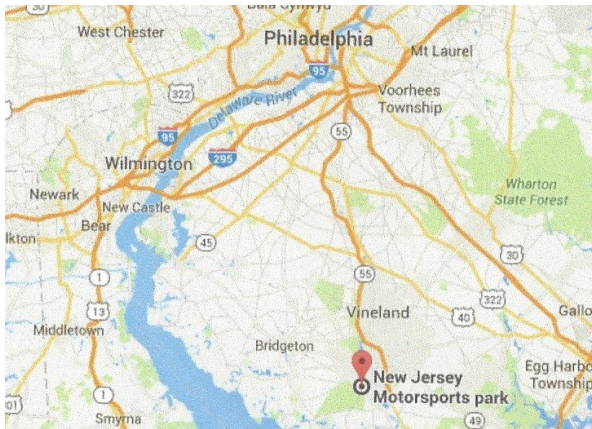
All our venues are close to the Hampton Inn, our host hotel. On Thursday and Friday you will have the opportunity to visit one of the following nearby attractions: Wheaton Village, Millville Army Air Field Museum, Matchbox Museum or Bellview Winery.

Host Hotel Headquarters

The Hampton Inn & Suites, a spacious and modern facility located 11 miles from the New Jersey Motorsports Park, will serve as our Meet Headquarters. The room rate will be \$119+ taxes per night. It will be your responsibility to reserve your own room. Please see hotel information on reverse side for alternative listing of area hotels.

All activities and banquet will take place at the New Jersey Motorsports Park.

Self Contained Motor Home And Trailer Parking

There will be ample space available for motor homes at \$50.00 regardless of stay (no hook ups) at the NJ Motorsports Park. There are a limited number of motorhome spaces available with electric at an additional cost. Trailer parking will be available at the NJ Motorsports Park at \$20.00 regardless of stay. There will also be limited trailer parking available at the Hampton Inn at \$20. South Jersey Region workers (wearing red logo t-shirts) will be available beginning at noon on Thursday, May 19th to assist with parking. Please note: a motor home pulling a trailer will be \$70.00 regardless of stay and will be parked together. Please enter at the Main Gate at the NJ Motorsports Park.

Show Day

The Saturday car show will be held on the show field at the NJ Motorsports Park. Registration will be from 7:00 am till 11:00 am at the show field. Judging of show cars will begin promptly at 11:00 am. All vehicles must remain on the show field till 3:00 pm. Enter at Main Gate.

Flea Market and Car Corral

You are encouraged to visit the Flea Market and Car Corral that is located at the NJ Motorsports Park. The Flea Market and Car Corral will be operating from 8:00 am till 5:00 pm daily beginning Friday, May 20th, and from 8:00 am till 3:00 pm on Saturday. Car Corral limited to 1991 and earlier non-modified vehicles. Space size 10 x 30. All Flea Market and Car Corral spaces are \$35 per space.

Car Wash

Located at the Hampton Inn and NJ Motorsports Park complex. You will need to bring your own towels and supplies.

Security

Overnight security will be provided at the NJ Motorsports Park from 10:00 pm till 6:00 am, Thursday and Friday nights only.

Spectator Parking

There will be ample free parking at the NJ Motorsports Park. Enter at the Main Gate.

For your convenience, one stop shopping, registration, drinks and munchies will be available during posted hours at the Hampton Inn Hospitality Room.

Day of show, registration will take place at the NJ Motorsports Park.

We will also have chances available for a selection of distinctive merchandise. Winners will be announced at 2:00 PM on the Show Field.

Note: AACA merchandise and raffle tickets will be available Saturday at the NJ Motorsports Park.

Judging

Judging school will be held Friday, May 20th from 2:00 to 4:00 pm at the NJ Motorsports Park. The Judges breakfast will be on Saturday, May 21st from 8:00 to 9:00 am at the NJ Motorsports Park. Reserved judges parking will be available at the NJ Motorsports Park.

Tours

All tours are on your own and directions will be provided to the various venues with regard to hours of operation etc.

Wheaton Arts & Cultural Center— Located in Millville, NJ. This unique national cultural treasure is located on 65 wooded acres in the New Jersey Pine Lands. There will be glass blowing in one of the country's first amphitheater-style Hot Glass Studios where professional artists will be demonstrating a variety of glassmaking techniques. Over 275 artists from around the world have come to Wheaton Arts to develop their skills and share their unique talents. Note: there is a fee to enter Wheaton Arts.

The Millville Army Air Field Museum—Appreciate and enjoy United States aviation and military history in the original base headquarters of America's First Defense Airport. No other airport in the country boasts as many original WWII buildings as Millville. You will see a collection of artifacts that span from the beginning of flight to present day. Note that admission to the Museum is free, but donations are greatly appreciated.

The Matchbox Museum—The Matchbox Museum is one of South Jersey's best-kept secrets. This jaw dropping collection is approaching 40,000 pieces on display. The first Matchbox toy was designed in 1952 and can be seen in the museum. Everett Marshall, owner of the Museum has many of the toys he played with and enjoys showing this unique hobby.

The Bellview Winery—The winery is located on the same farm that owner Jim Quarella's great grandfather purchased in 1914 after immigrating from Italy. You will be able to taste the wines, take a tour and talk to the winemaker.

Membership Roundtable

Friday, May 20th - 4:00 to 5:00 pm at the NJ Motorsports Park. Roundtables provide an excellent way to communicate with your national directors on how AACA is functioning, what we can do better, and what we should be doing in the future.

Youth Program

On Saturday an entertaining and educational program geared towards all age groups will take place from 11:00 am to 1:00 pm at the NJ Motorsports Park adjacent to the show field. Scheduled are automotive related contests for the younger ones and for the old ones a hands on session of how to work on an antique vehicle using tools of the day. All youth are encouraged to attend.
