Fire Extinguishers Recalled



Just recently a recall was announced involving 40 million fire extinguishers manufactured by Kidde. The recall involves 134 models of Kidde fire extinguishers manufactured between January 1, 1973 and August 15, 2017, including

models that were previously recalled in March 2009 and February 2015. Be advised that some of 2 medium Zucchini, sliced the recalled extinguishers were sold under names other than Kidde (i.e. Fuller Brush, Honeywell, Montgomery Ward, Sears and other names).

Be advised that the link above has the list of recalled extinguishers. It also lets you submit your request for a replacement extinguisher after you provide your name, address, the model extinguisher and serial number. It verifies that your extinguisher is being recalled and submits your request for a replacement. If you do not want to submit your request online, you can contact Kidde via telephone to find out if a fire extinguisher is included in the recall or to get a replacement. Contact Kidde at 855-271-0773 between 8:30 a.m. and 5 p.m. EST Monday-Friday (excluding holidays), or between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. during the weekend to determine whether your extinguishers are affected.

Given how many AACA members have fire extinguishers for their vehicles, we have no doubt that some AACA members have extinguishers that are being recalled. Please take action on this situation immediately and be sure to share this information with all of your region and chapter members as soon as possible.

RECIPE OF THE MONTH



From the Kitchen of Judy Fischer

SAUSAGE SOUP

2 lbs Italian sausage (hot, sweet or mixed) remove casings and crumble

8 oz. medium shells—cooked (firm) and drained

2 cloves garlic, minced

1 medium green pepper, chopped

1 - 28 oz. can Italian tomatoes

1 1/2 cup dry red wine

3 Tbsp. chopped fresh parsley

2 large onions, chopped

3 - 14 oz. cans college inn beef broth

1/2 tsp. basil

Remove casings from sausage, crumple and fry till lightly browned. Add garlic and onions, fry till limp. Stir in tomatoes, add broth, wine and basil. Bring to a boil, reduce heat and simmer for 30 minutes. Add parsley, peppers, zucchini and cooked shells. Cover and simmer for 25 minutes (salt, pepper & garlic power to taste). Serve with parmesan cheese.




