TRIVIA FROM THE 1940'S AND 1950'S



In the 1940's sealed beam headlights became an industry standard.

In 1940 many models that year set an industry standard by installing a heater and defroster.

In 1941 nearly all automobile models had a column gear shift and enclosed running boards. Dodge offered to install running boards for \$10.00.

1950 and 1951 Oldsmobile made stock car history. In 1950 they won 10 of 19 and in 1951 they won 20 of 41 of the major stock car races with their "Olds Rocket V-8" 135 horsepower motor.

In December of 1951 the U.S. built the 100 millionth automobile.

1952 It was recorded the V-8 engine was installed in at least 1/3 of all new automobiles.

1955 The first McDonald's drive in opened.

1955 Chrysler's C-300 supercar dominated NASCAR racing.

1957 American cars began to switch to quad (4 across) headlamps but were ruled temporarily illegal in several states.

1957 Dodge's A-D-500 had a Hemi V-8 at 340 horsepower.
